2) Correction and Adoption of 13th November 2015 Minutes

3) Matters Arising from 13th November 2015 Meeting

- a) 4(a) The Bank has now found our our account paperwork. The Treasurer proposed that the Chairman, Vice-Chaiman, Secretary and Treasurer be signatories on the Area accounts. He will organise all the paperwork.
- b) 7(a) Steve Dunn is currently paying for session at Leeds Trinity University and charging £10 per flyer with limited places being available. Alec Barber mention their indoor flying sessions and funding. D&DMAC proposed that the Area fund 4 x £50 session each over the next 12 month period for both Alec's and Steve's events as long as they advertised on the Area and main BMFA web sites. a) The Treasurer said we have received £4.86 interest from our accounts.

5) Officer's Reports

a) Chairmans Report

Well it seems an age since the last meeting; however it's been a very quiet new year so far and very little to report. The Deadline for members to display models at the forthcoming Doncaster Model Engineering Exhibition has passed and to date we had no expressions of interest. So the decision was to taken to inform Lou (show organiser) that we unfortunately would not be taking up his kind offer this year. I hope that if the invitation to attend is extended to us next year then we may be in a better position to provide some sort of display, but it still feels a little disappointing as it seems we missed an opportunity to engage with the public and potential new model aviators.

6) Comments on Officer's Reports

a) The Treasurer reiterated that an income/expenses slip must be sent to him for any income or expenses for the Area.

7) A.O.B

- a) Andy Symons let the Area know that Peter Willis has now moved out of the Area and has resigned as Delegate and ASC. Andy said he would be happy to take over as ASC for the moment.
- b) Andy Symons as ASC put forward Chris Bell (Winterton Club) as a fixed wing examiner. This was proposed by DMFC and seconded by D&DMAC. For 6, against 0.
- c) Andy Symons put forward that the Area run an examiners workshop in early September at either PANDAS or Winterton. He will let the Area know when the details have been confirmed.
- d) Andy Symons pointed out that club examiners can subscribe on http://achievements.bmfa.org/ for updates to the achievement schemes.
- e) Andrew Watson asked if the rumours of Dishforth Airfield closing were true. The Secretary responded that as far as he knew this is not the case.
- f) KADMAC asked the Area to help to fund a gravel path at their flying site for disabled users. Andy Symons suggested that they contact the local Council first. Alec Barber suggested that they also contact their local councillor. The meeting agreed that it would need an idea of cost before agreeing to paying for it.
- g) Martin Lynn raised issues he had with the agenda for the BMFA meeting. First he raised the proposal to add a joining fee to BMFA membership. D&DMAC proposed that we oppose this. Seconded by DMFC. For 6, against 0. Second he raised the proposed changes to how Areas are funded. It was thought there was not enough time to discuss and look at this so it was proposed by D&DMAC to have this deferred to the next BMFA meeting. This was seconded by W&DA. For 6, against 0.
- h) Andy Symons mentioned that he run the BMFA stand at Winterton (6/7th August) and Elvington (13/14th August). He said that he would need help at Elvington and Robert Day said he would help.
- Robert Day said that himself and Alan Muir would be happy to run indoor flying again at Leeds Trinity University. **PANDAS** proposed that we run the same number of events for 2016/17. Seconded by **BMF**. For 6, against 0.
