7) A.O.B

- a) Andy Symons pointed out that the Electric Indoor Masters is on the 14/15th January.
- b) Phillip Kent asked if the Area would fund four 2 hour sessions @ £20 per hour at Batley Sports Centre during the school holidays. This was proposed by BMF and seconded by H&DMAC. For 10, 0 against.
- c) Andy Symons asked that when the minutes of the meetings are sent out recipients are bcc (blind copied) instead of cc (copied) so that the recipients cannot see other recipients addresses.
- d) Andy Symons pointed out the BMFA is compiling a list of drone friendly clubs to put on the BMFA Web Site.
- e) Mike Sollitt discussed scale flying competitions and pointed out that they can be boring for spectators to watch. He proposed to get spectators involved by asking them to judge flights and those nearest to the judges scores win a prize. So **SMF** proposed that the Area fund two prizes of £100 for the Skelbrooke and PANDAS scale events. This was seconded by **D&DMAC**. For 10, 0 against.
- f) Mike Sollitt proposed that there should be scale model competitions for smaller models. The meeting discussed this.
- g) Mike Sollitt is doing a scale model talk at **D&DMAC** on Thursday 9th March.
- h) Andy Symons raised that the Area should be using social media to publicise itself and Area events more. Rob Day has already set-up an Area Facebook site.
